Writing Criteria: A

Narrative Writing- Personal: Personal Narratives are first person stories about events we have experienced in our lives.

Grade 1

Ideas/Research

Generates ideas

Tells about event/s or time

Tells only true information

Includes related details

Organization/Text Features

Includes a title that relates closely to the story

Relates two or more sequenced events in appropriate time order

Includes beginning, middle and end

Includes some details regarding what happened

Includes a sense of closure

Includes pictures that match text

Includes labels and captions on pictures

Language Style

Uses first person for personal narratives

Uses temporal words to signal event order (first, next, etc.)

Uses descriptive words

Uses action words
