Narrative Writing- Personal: Personal Narratives are first person stories about events we have experienced in our lives.

Grade 2

Ideas/Research

Generates ideas

Recounts a well-elaborated event or short sequence of events

Gives the reader factual information

Includes vivid, engaging details

Organization/Text Features

Includes a title that relates closely to the narrative

Relates an event or sequence of events in time order

Includes beginning, middle and end

Includes details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings

Includes pictures that match text

Includes labels and captions on pictures

Includes a sense of closure

Language Style

Uses first person for personal narratives

Uses consistent verb tense

Uses descriptive words

Uses temporal words to signal event order
