## **Writing Criteria: B**

#### Key Skills and Understanding

Narrative Writing - Fictional: Fictional narratives are about an imagined event or scenario created by the author.

Grade K

#### Ideas/Research

Generates ideas

Tells about imaginary event

Includes related details

#### **Organization/Text Features**

Includes a title that tells what the piece is about

Relates an event or sequence of events in time order

Includes beginning, middle and end

Includes a sense of closure

Includes pictures that match text

Includes labels and captions on pictures

#### **Language Style**

Uses first person or third person

Uses temporal words to signal event order (first, next, etc.)

Uses descriptive words

Uses action words
