Writing Criteria: D

Informational/Explanatory - Instruct: Writing to instruct explains how to make or do something.

Grade 3

Ideas/Research

Reflects research and planning

Includes facts, definitions, and details from research

Summarizes information from multiple sources

Lists/cites sources

Organization/Text Features

Includes a title that tells what the procedure is

Provides a list of materials

Presents numbered steps listed in sequence

Includes illustrations (labeled diagrams) that match the text

Includes a concluding statement or section

Language Style

Puts information in his or her own words

Uses strong present-tense verbs

Uses precise vocabulary

Uses linking words such as *when*, *if*, *first*, *next*, *then*, and *finally* to connect ideas

Demonstrates sentence fluency and uses a variety of sentence lengths
