Ideas/Research

Expresses opinion about a topic or book

Bases writing on personal opinion

Gathers and uses information from text or multiple sources

Organization/Text Features

Includes a title that reflects topic or goal

Begins with an opening statement that reveals the goal

Provides a reason or argument for opinion

Ends with a sentence or statement that restates the goal (closure)

Includes visuals that supports the opinion

Language Style

Shows a clear consistent opinion throughout the piece

Uses inviting, descriptive language

Uses and to join ideas
